TWO 1/4 ACRE KITS

Each 1/4 Acre Kit irrigates a total of 2,000 feet of rows of vegetables. The school already has a tank elevated high enough to provide pressure for the 1/4 acre kits.

The school’s objective is to be able to produce enough vegetables for the entire school.
